Fire Hydrants – Please take a moment to care for a fire hydrant near your house or in your neighborhood. In the event an emergency occurs, a fire hydrant is our lif- line and is essential to an efficient and safe operation. This season, please be sure hydrants are not blocked by parked guests, and in the event of snow, take a few minutes and clear around the hydrant.

*House Numbers – The Georgetown Fire Department responds to over 700 requests for service per year. Most are to private residences. We cannot emphasize enough, the importance of **prominently** displayed house numbers. Often times we as homeowners take this small, but critical home accessory for granted. Take a few moments and check to see if your house number is easily visible from the street in the daylight as well as in darkness. It could make the difference when seconds count.
