CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 62C, §49A, I certify under the penalties of perjury that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, I am in compliance with all laws of the Commonwealth relating to taxes, reporting of employees and contractors, and withholding and remitting child support.

Under Section 35 of the Chapter 233, political subdivision and agencies of the Commonwealth must annually furnish to the Commissioner of Revenue a list of all persons who have provided goods, services or real estate space in the aggregate of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or more.

The undersigned hereby certifies that he is able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of the labor employed, or to be employed on the work, that all employees to be employed at the worksite will have successfully completed a United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration course that is at least ten (10) hours in duration at the time the employee begins work and who shall furnish documentation of successful completion of said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee; and that he will comply fully with all laws and regulations applicable to awards made subject to Section 44A.
- G. The undersigned further certifies under the penalties of perjury that this bid is in all respects bona fide, fair and made without collusion or fraud with any other person. As used in this subsection the word "person" shall mean any natural person, joint venture, partnership, corporation or other business or legal entity. The undersigned further certifies under penalty of perjury that the said undersigned is not presently debarred from doing public construction work in the Commonwealth under the provisions of Section 29F of Chapter 29, or any other applicable debarment provisions of any other chapter of the General Laws or any rule or regulation promulgated thereunder.
