## Meeting Motions / Actions and Summary of Discussions:

Colleen reported that Georgetown Senior Community Center facility is in good shape. Board members discussed the reopening plans underway for the Georgetown Senior Center. The reopening plan continues essential services as well as the return of limited and pre-registered exercise groups and other small group activities to be followed by additional programs and activities in upcoming months. Colleen reviewed pandemic service statistics that the COA provided from March 2020 through June 2021. The \$175,859 Annual COA Budget was approved as part of the Town's omnibus budget at the annual town meeting. In a motion by Diane Klibansky with a second by Martha Lucius, board members unanimously approved the current slate of COA officers including Sue Clay, as Chair, Darcy Norton as Vice Chair and Jill Benas as Secretary who will all return for the next fiscal year. Colleen has applied for a \$656 Helping Hand Mini Grant Program to pay for the cost of new tires for the van from the state Department of Transportation. Colleen introduced Susan Dysert, social work intern from St. Joseph's College who will intern at the COA until November. Upcoming events planned for the fall will include theater productions by Delvena Theater in September and December. Tea and refreshments will be served. A Flu Clinic will be held on November 3. Senator Tarr and Re. Mirra's legislative aides will hold monthly office hours beginning in August. In a motion by Darcy Norton with a second by Diane Klibansky, board members accepted the Treasurer's Report. In a motion by Esther Palardy with a second by Jeanne Robertson, board members accepted the Director's report.
