## Re: Regional Services to Promote Community Protective Factors -

Superintendent Jacobs informed us that the City of Newburyport was awarded a 3 year grant from the <u>Tower Foundation</u> to fund a Regional Prevention Initiative. They will be received about \$130Kyear. This grant will fund a full time position to serve as a coordinator to assist in the creation of Positive Youth Development committees in the Greater Newburyport area, funding for completing the search institute's student survey on developmental assets and high risk behaviors and regional campaigns. The funding begins on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
