At 7:06 pm, the meeting started with Mr. introducing Michèle Grenier.

This was a meeting to interview potential Conservation Agent candidate hire, Michele Grenier.

Carl asked Michele to give a brief overview of her resume and qualifications for the job.

Michele stated her certifications, qualifications and her past positions held within municipalities – which include a stint as Chair of the Board of Selectmen in the town of Middleborough. Her qualifications include a BS in Public Administration, a Masters Degree in Leadership and Masters Degree in Human Resource Management. She also informed the members that she has taken all the MACC fundamental courses to be an efficient Conservation Director and has a PWS – Professional Wetland Scientist certification from the State of Massachusetts.

R. Bancroft asked how she handles enforcement issues. M. Grenier commented that she treats everyone the same, she will visit the site or homeowner and apply the same wetland laws or by-laws to everybody. Give them a chance to come into compliance. Only when they make absolutely no effort Ms. Grenier will issue an Enforcement.

C. Candia inquired about how long she has been a Conservation Agent. M. Grenier has been actively involved in the fields as a municipal agent, assistant planner and Town Planner or private sector wetland scientist since the 90's.

M. Grenier inquired how long before she hears a response. C. Shreder replied that it should not be more than a week or two.
