## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE Georgetown Planning Board

The Georgetown Planning Board will hold a public hearing on 27 March 2024, at 7:00 P.M. in accordance with the state mandated amendment language to MGL C. 40A, Section 3A, i.e., provisions for the town to provide a minimum of 750 non-age restricted multi-family housing units, by right, proposed to be provided within the Town's Bylaw in Section 165-60, and in accordance with the proposed Zoning Overlay District, to consist of at least 50 acres, and generally identified, herein, as a 61 acre (+/-) area comprised of multiple parcels, developed or otherwise, and in and around the area of Georgetown known locally as "downtown", and further identified as the vicinity surrounding the intersection of MA Routes 97 and 133 in Georgetown.
