

The following data has been reported to the PD on a daily basis from the Public Health Nurse. We track cases to ensure a safe EMS response.

With 79 reported cases thus far in the month of November, we're on track for ~129 cases by month's end. For comparison, December 2020 is the month we had the most cases (109).

A message from the Board of Health:

The increase in Covid 19 cases in Town as demonstrated by Chief Cudmore's graphic representation above is what has warranted the Board of Health's issuance of the Advisory Order for the general public's awareness, and to get them to reflect again about the risks that Covid 19 poses.

In 2020 we were all still wearing face coverings and social distancing, and our case count was significantly less.

The Board of Health is hopeful that all citizens will give some serious thought about the increase in cases, the time of year (as flu season is upon us); and their own and their families safety; as we approach the holiday season with potentially large family and social gatherings about to occur.

The Advisory Order was sent out as a reminder that Covid 19 and its variants have not disappeared, and we need to still protect ourselves. Although not popular, the simple implementation of the proper safety protocols, such as wearing face covering and social distancing when we are inside, can help prevent spread of infection and can help keep everyone safer.
