Any permanent structures such as sheds, furniture, rugs, large compost buckets, large stone structures, must be removed by April 1.

Watering cans, buckets, and hoses are permitted. Temporary fences, hand tools, weed whackers and rototillers are permitted.

On March 15, plots will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. From Jan 1-March 14, the prior occupant of the plot will have priority to repurchase that same plot, with a family limit of two.

This is an organic garden. No pesticides please.



Our Community Gardens are located on Route 133 in Georgetown across from the Black Swan Country Club.

Plots are 30x30. Rental cost is \$25.00 each for the growing season. Plots are limited to two per family. Plot assignment preference is given to gardeners from the prior year up until March 14. March 15 it then becomes first come first serve for garden plot assignments. Water taps are provided.
