The GWD is currently offering a rebate program for residents who are looking to upgrade certain household items to more energy/water efficient models. As of today, 4/15/2015, only the following items are eligible for a rebate:

HIGH EFFICIENCY TOILETS
HIGH EFFICIENCY WASHING MACHINES

The rebate amount for the items above are:

\$200 rebate for qualifying Toilets & \$100 rebate for qualifying Washing Machines

If you are interested in upgrading to one of the above mentioned items, the following is a checklist of qualifications each will need to cover in order to be approved for the rebate program.

High-Efficiency Toilets (HET)

- WaterSense listed High Efficiency Toilets (HETs use or average 1.28 gallon per flush or less), See http://www.epa.gov/watersense/product_search.html, are eligible for the rebate program.
- New toilets must replace a toilet using at least 3.5 gallons per flush
- New toilet must be installed in a current Georgetown residence, connected to the Georgetown Water System
- New toilets **MUST** be installed by a MA licensed plumber.

Documentation Required:

- Completed rebate form w/ original signatures
- Proof of purchase (invoice or cash receipt) dated within 30 days of the rebate request
- Plumber signature (will need to be MA certified and prove their licenses number as well as signature on the rebate form at the time of install.)

High-Efficiency Washing Machine

- EnergyStar Water Factor of 5.0 or less are eligible for the rebate program.
- New washers must replace a Washer using over a 5.0 water factor.
- New washers must be installed in a current Georgetown residence, connected to the Georgetown Water System

Documentation Required:

- Completed rebate form w/ original signatures
- Proof of purchase (invoice or cash receipt) dated within 30 days of the rebate request
