Running for Office

The first step to run for any office is to obtain nomination papers from the Town Clerk. Nomination papers are available the 1^{st} Monday in February and prior notification will be given on the Georgetown website $\underline{\text{www.georgetownma.gov}}$, under the Town Clerks page, the message board out front of Town Hall and your Local Cable Access Station.

The Town Clerk will advise you how many signatures you'll need to obtain for your nomination papers, when the deadline is to file your nomination papers with the Town Clerks Office, also the deadline to withdraw your nomination if you choose, as well as any questions you may have.

Once all signatures have been gathered and nomination papers filed with the Town Clerk, we will then certify the signatures. Once the signatures are certified the names will go on the ballot, incumbent first, then alphabetical by last name.

All information, questions and forms needed to run a campaign will be on the Office of Campaign Political Finance website at www.OCPF.us.

Georgetown Annual Town Elections are held the 2nd Monday in May.
